Dear Sir,

Sub: The news that come in the leading newspapers on 12th Jan 2011.

An unfortunate incident happened recently when a child of 18 months old met with a tragic death. Initial investigations suggest that it may have been caused by a community dog. The area where this incident took place; Bagalur falls out of the limits of BBMP and is therefore not under the network of dog control centers in Bangalore.

Many of us are horrified about this episode and naturally want to know how and why this happened. While 98% of street dogs are docile and merely bark when agitated, 2% of them can turn aggressive. Since dogs rely on garbage dumps for their food, an easy way of curbing their population is to maintain good standards of public hygiene. Unfortunately, overflowing garbage bins are a common sight on Bangalore's streets. Pieces thrown out after slaughtering the animals lie around these stalls and one can immediately see groups of dogs engaged in a bitter battle for these scraps we have been informing you about it several times (Letter Enclosed).

It has been scientifically proven across India that dog population control can be achieved through a two pronged method: Animal Birth Control and public hygiene. The Animal Birth Control project in Bangalore is one of the best in India.

What is left for us to do is to focus our energies on revamping the public hygiene system. An important step would be to remove the meat stalls on the outskirts of Bangalore which would result in people purchasing meat and fish from shops, markets and supermarkets. Garbage collection and disposal also needs to be organised in a manner that discourages street dogs from gathering around them. We can be rest assured that Bangalore will be a far safer city than it is today.

Sub: Increasing Effectiveness of Animal Birth Control programme

At the outset we would like to congratulate you for starting the ABC programme in Bangalore in right earnest in the year 2000. We are happy to have you back as Commissioner.


The ABC programme is going well, but we feel that there is a lot of scope of improvement in the same. Some of the main areas for improvement (given in detail as separate annexures) are:

- a) Inclusion of CMCs in BMP ABC programme. Annexure I
- b) Introduction of Intradermal method of administering human anti-rabies vaccinations which reduce the cost of human ARVs by 60%. Annexure II
- c) Regulation of Pet dog market, which could be a major source of funds for BMP. Annexure III
- d) Regulation of illegal meat stalls. Annexure IV

For the above we have time and again given proposals but unfortunately nothing has happened. We wish that under your able guidance, some of these issues could be taken up for implementation.
